

MONMOUTH SCHOOL SPORTS CLUB
RULES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

1. Membership

- Single membership is open to adults aged 18 years and over.
- Family membership comprises X2 adults and their children under 18 years of age. All living at the same address.
- Individual children attaining the age of 18 years old within the duration of a family membership will be removed from the membership and notification sent to the account holder. This excludes pupils of the school who will remain members until leaving school.
- Parents of school pupils whom receive discount membership rates will be notified of a change in status and their membership fees adjusted after their child leaves the school. Immediately for DD payers & at renewal for paid in full customers.
- Prospective members must submit a completed application form together with the appropriate fee/s.
- Membership is at the discretion of Monmouth School Sports Club Management.
- Paid in full membership duration will be 1 year from your date of application. (Less if taking a shorter period membership). Monthly subscriptions by direct debit will continue until notice of cancellation is received. It is the responsibility of clients wishing to terminate their direct debit to do so at their bank and MSSC will accept no responsibility for DD payments left live by clients after notification of cancellation.
- Paid in full membership renewals will be back dated to date of expiry (unless otherwise stated). After 1 month lapse the membership will be terminated unless otherwise stated.
- All adult members will be issued with a membership card. The membership card must be presented at reception on each occasion the member uses The Sports Club and at any other time when requested by a member of Sports Club staff. The membership card remains the property of Monmouth School and must be returned on termination of membership.
- Membership is non- transferable and the fee is non-refundable.
- Membership fees are fixed for one year and any increases thereafter will be by one month's notice. Membership fees are fixed for each subsequent year at the rate prevailing at the beginning of each subscription year.
- Defaults in Direct Debit/cheque payments will incur a £10.00 charge.
- All members are welcome to alter their membership status (upgrade/downgrade etc)
All upgrades will be free of charge. Other changes to membership after 1 initial change will incur a £10.00 charge.
- The Sports Club will close for a period of time annually to allow essential maintenance. Allowance for closure is reflected in the annual subscription fee. (Normally a few days in December of each year).
- The Sports Club will additionally be closed for 1 day per school holiday to facilitate staff training. (Normally the first Wednesday of each holiday) and some additional days across the Xmas/ New Year holidays.
- Communication the Club will from time to time use email as a means of communication with users. Please note any email information sent will be from MSSC only and you can request removal from the list at any time.

2. Members Conduct

- The facilities of The Sports Club are open to members at the times listed on the current published timetables. The Sports Club reserves the right to amend the opening times with all possible prior notice given to all users.
- Monmouth School Sports Club has a No Smoking policy. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the building and campus.
- No alcohol may be consumed on the premises, unless as part of a Special Function sanctioned by Monmouth School.

- The Sports Club Management reserve the right to refuse access to anyone suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or other controlled substances.
- Patrons are required to wear clean and appropriate clothing and footwear for their chosen activity. (If in doubt please seek advice from a member of staff).
- Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
NB i. The supervising adult must be a capable swimmer (If children are using the Swimming Pool). Children over 8 years may use the Sports Club unaccompanied.
NB.ii. Any child deemed to be incapable of participating in their chosen activity safely will be requested to stop and their Parent(s) contacted.
NBiii. Any activity undertaken by an adult or child deemed to be unsafe by a Sports Club staff member, will be stopped immediately.
- An adult may accompany a maximum of 3 children under 8 years of age.
- All members wishing to use the Fitness Suite are strongly advised to undergo induction training with The Sports Club Fitness Instructors. (Anyone not undertaking an induction will have to sign a disclaimer form. Available from reception)
NB Children under 16 years old are not permitted to use the Fitness Suite.
- Members and their guests are advised not to undertake any activity for which they may be medically unfit. Monmouth School and it's officers will not be in any way responsible for any harm which may have resulted to a Member or Guest from undertaking within The Sports Club any activity which is beyond their physical capability.
- Members are advised not to leave money or other valuables at The Sports Club.
- Members and their guests must obey the rules as laid down by The Sports Club for the use of individual facilities.

3. Guests

- Members are permitted to invite a Maximum of 6 guests at any one time, up to 6 times per year. Each guest must be booked in at Reception. (Guest fees must be paid on entry, please see current tariff for fees).
- Members will be responsible for ensuring their guests obey the Rules, Terms and Conditions of The Sports Club.
- A current member must accompany all guests.

4. Termination of Membership

- Officers of Monmouth School and Sports Club have the right to refuse entry, stop an activity, bar any patrons from participating in an activity or order from the premises anyone who is deemed to be in breach of these Rules, Terms and Conditions or for any other reason which may be deemed detrimental to patrons, guests, users, staff and/or the campus as a whole.
- Members wishing to terminate their Membership are requested to do so in writing to The Manager.
- The Sports Club Management reserves the right to terminate Membership at any time.
- Direct Debit payments: It is the responsibility of the member to cancel their Direct Debit agreement with their bank at time of termination of membership.

Monmouth School and it's employees will not in anyway be liable for the loss or damage to the property or for personal injury to or death of any Member or Guest, except to the extent that such loss, damage, personal injury or death arises from the wilful act, neglect or default of Monmouth School, Monmouth School Sports Club and or it's officers or agents.
